17. DELEGATE Designate a wedding planner, friend, or family member to handle wedding day concerns, says Kiersten Pierce, owner of Gooseberry Creative Events in Decatur, Georgia.

18. RELAX AND ENJOY Dig in. "Eat your dinner! Many brides get caught up in talking with guests and forget to enjoy the day," says Josie Littlepage, owner of Cosmopolitan Events in St. Louis.

19. TIME IT RIGHT "Leave time for things to get done on the wedding day," suggest Jeannie Uyanik and Elizabeth West of C&G Weddings in New York. (If the drive tends to take 30 minutes, plan for an hour to be safe.)

20. PAY ATTENTION TO DETAIL "Customize details so they reflect your couple style," says Debi Lilly of A Perfect Event in Chicago. Like to travel? Give luggage tags as favors.
